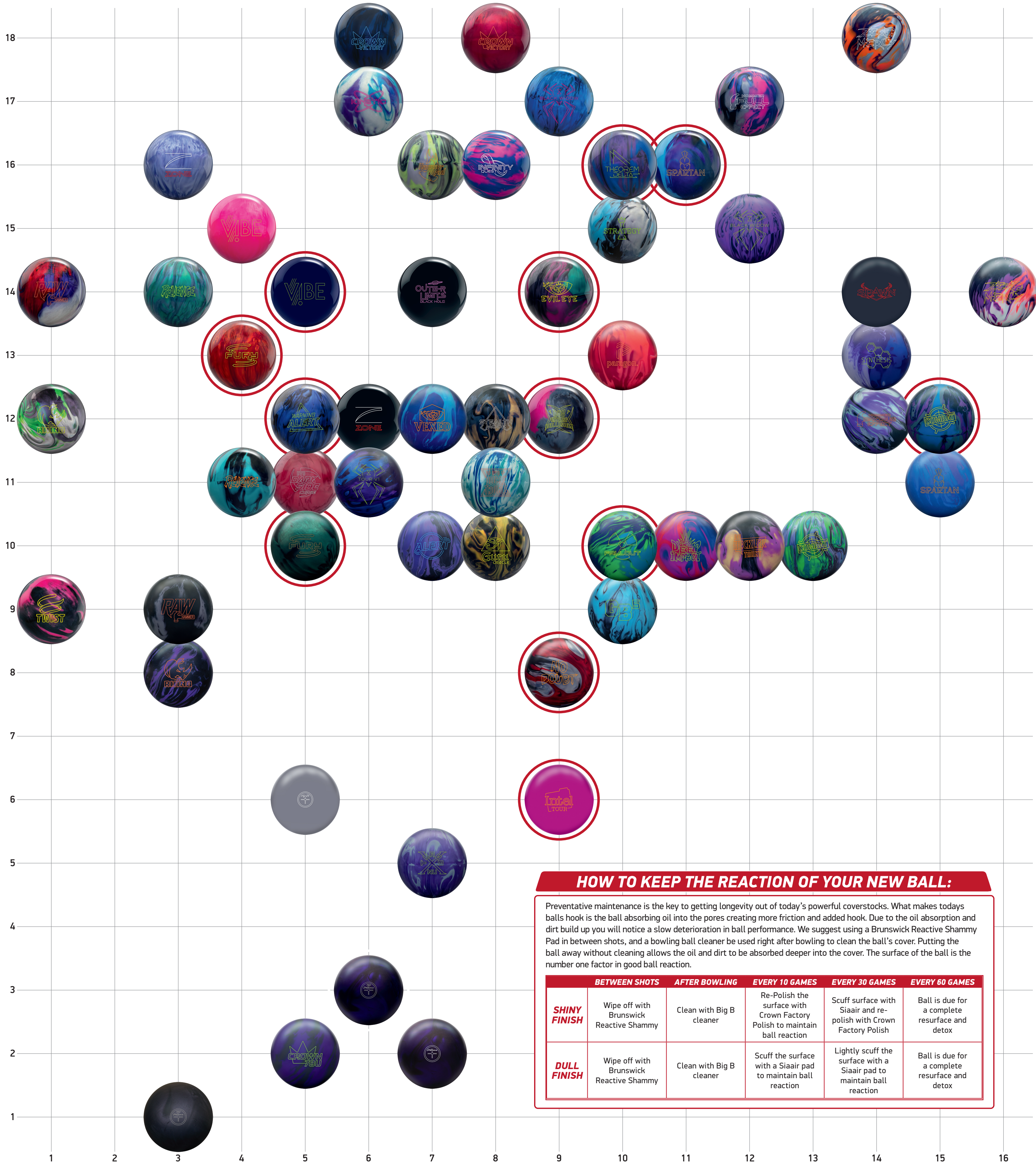


BALL MOTION COMPARISON CHART

HOW TO KEEP THE REACTION OF YOUR NEW BALL:

Preventative maintenance is the key to getting longevity out of today's powerful coverstocks. What makes today's balls hook is the ball absorbing oil into the pores creating more friction and added hook. Due to the oil absorption and dirt build up you will notice a slow deterioration in ball performance. We suggest using a Brunswick Reactive Shabby Pad in between shots, and a bowling ball cleaner be used right after bowling to clean the ball's cover. Putting the ball away without cleaning allows the oil and dirt to be absorbed deeper into the cover. The surface of the ball is the number one factor in good ball reaction.
